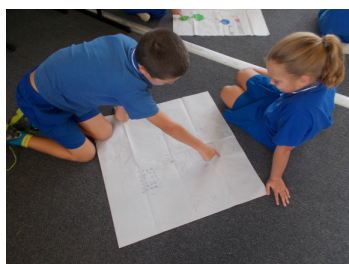
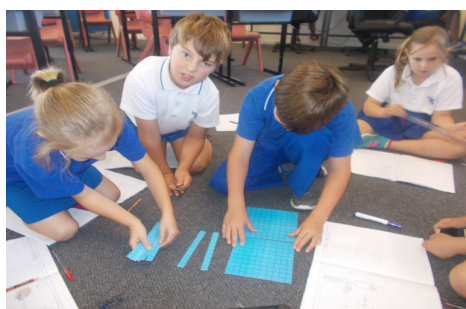
Students were visited by Mr John Budiselik. For the morning students worked to create poetry. We really enjoyed listening to his songs and working our own poetry into song.

Students have been completing a variety of number activities, focusing on Place Value, Rounding and Estimating.

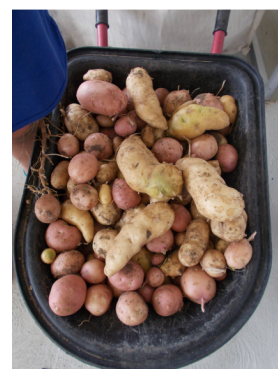


We had a visit from Josh Byrne!!! It was very exciting and we got to show him our plans and wish list for a Nature play ground. Then we did a tour of our gardens.

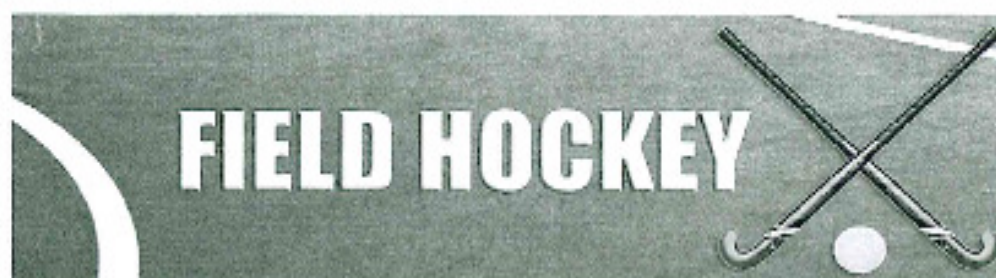
