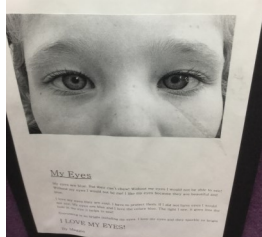
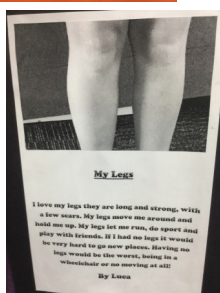
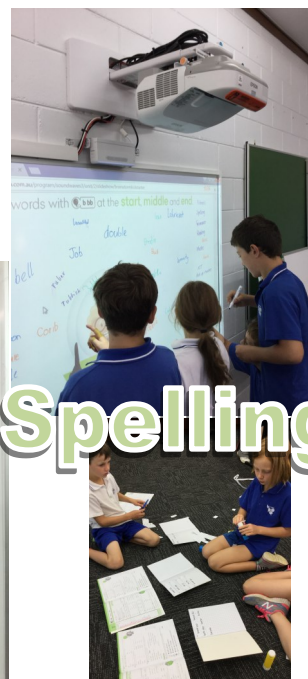
Maths: we have started the term strengthening our knowledge of place value and number. Students work on activities as a whole class, small groups and independently.
