The P&C meeting will be held on Thursday 14th November. We look forward as always to seeing as many of our parents and family members as possible at the meeting.

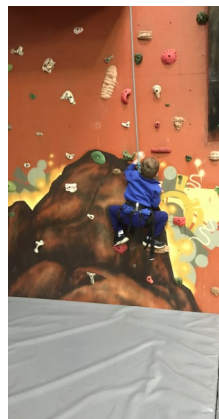
Swim Camp Payments
