The focus is on having fun and learning the skills and playing the game.





Bed wetting, also referred to as **Nocturnal Enuresis** is a common issue in many Australian households which affects children of all ages. This problem entails children who lack night-time bladder control, at an age which control is expected (between the ages of 5-19).

Esperance Population Health provides an 8 week program using a mat and bell system that can assist children to become dry from ages 5 ½ years to 17. You need to get a referral from the doctor to be eligible for the program.
